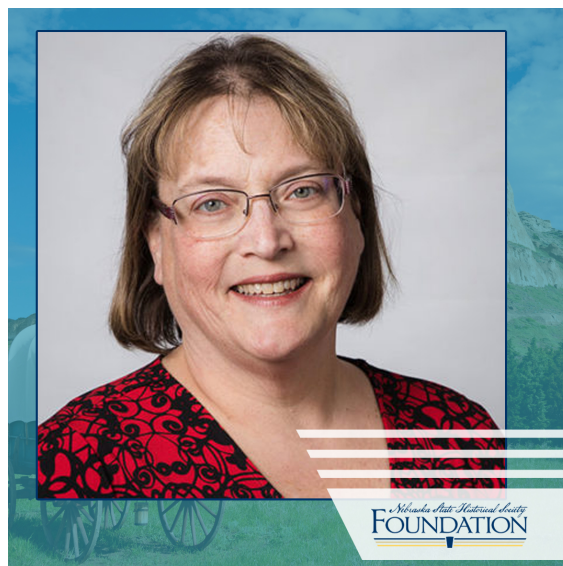

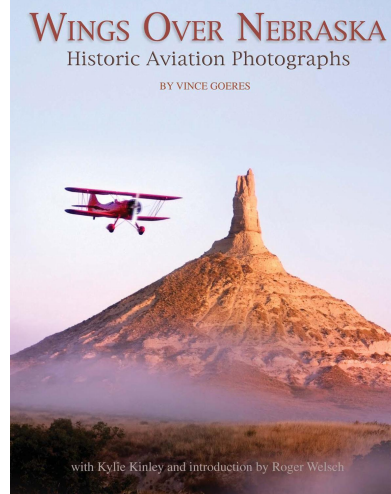

STATEWIDE GRANTS PROGRAM



We recently announced a new statewide historical grants program at the NSHS Foundation. Our goal is to establish a reliable source of dollars to be made available on an annual basis for local historical organizations and efforts all across the state.

Once this program is funded, we will award grants making these funds available to worthy ideas through an open application process. Our goal is to begin accepting applications on January 1, 2021, announcing winners on July 1, 2021.

Grants will benefit local historical and educational organizations providing programming and learning opportunities in community history. Examples of applying organizations include museums, historical societies, and libraries that use core educational, preservation and interpretive programs. Grants up to \$5,000 will be available.





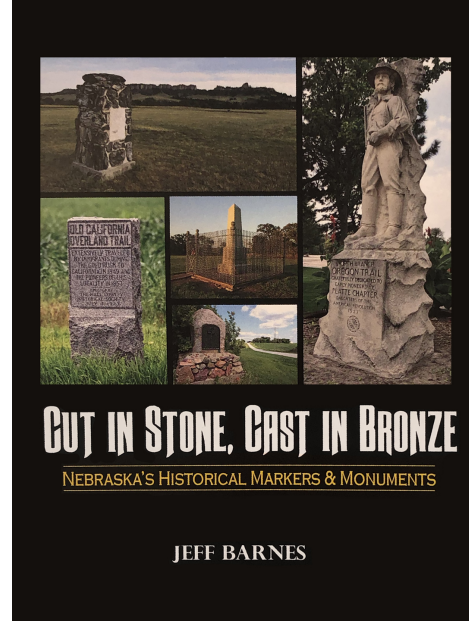
NSHSF FUNDRAISING PROJECT
