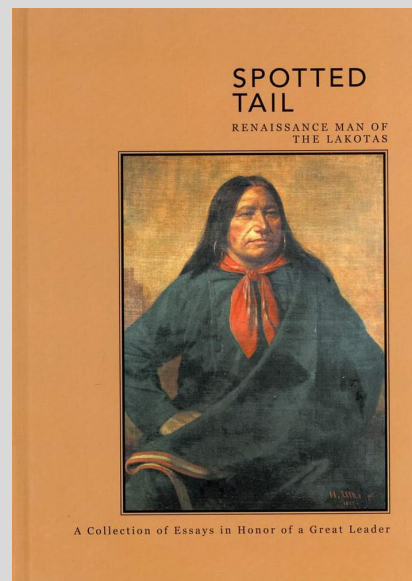
The Oregon Trail
