 - Any family members who served in WWII or the United States Military (if applicable).

- Original essay not to exceed two pages, based on your interview with a military veteran regarding his/her active service and describe how that encounter influenced and/or affected you.
 Please use Times New Roman 12 pt and line spacing of 1.5 for cover letter and essay.
- Current grade transcript
- Current resume that details your community and school activities, honors and awards
- Reference letter from one of your teachers and a second letter from someone other than a relative
