- Because you attend school in one of the home districts of the sailors entombed in the USS Arizona—which makes you eligible for this scholarship--share your thoughts on what that means to you.
• Original essay not to exceed two pages, based on your interview with a military veteran regarding his/her active service and describe how that encounter influenced and/or affected you.
Please use Times New Roman 12 pt and line spacing of 1.5 for cover letter and essay.
• Current grade transcript
• Current resume that details your community and school activities, honors and awards
• Reference letter from one of your teachers and a second letter from someone other than a relative
• Jpeg head and shoulders photo of yourself
