Seven Valleys Historical Museum received a grant for \$1000 towards a new roof and window for their historic jail, windows for a historic church, and plaster repair. Indianola Public Library received a grant for \$685 to purchase new shelving for historic documents (included in the picture above). The Custer County Museum received \$600 to fund an intern project, scan documents, and purchase new shelving. We are glad those grant funds were put to good use!
