

World War II and Pearl Harbor Memorial Scholarships

The Nebraska State Historical Society Foundation is happy to announce the Nebraskans of World War II Scholarship Fund and Pearl Harbor Remembrance Award recipients.

The Nebraskans of World War II Scholarship fund provides scholarships each year to Nebraskan high school seniors. This scholarship fund was established through a gift from the family of GM1c Edward Clough. Clough was killed during the attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 and remains entombed aboard the U.S.S. Arizona. His sister, Helen, chose to honor his memory through this generous gift.

Another Nebraska serviceman, Lt. Adrian DePutron, was killed during the Battle of the Bulge on January 20, 1945, while serving in General Patton's Third Army. Lt. DePutron's aunt, Marjorie Barstow, honored her nephew's service through her estate with a gift to help enhance the scholarship program. Those receiving the Nebraskans of WWII Scholarships are Ellie Glenn, Kaitlyn Emmanuel, Kylie Hansen, Caleb Hans, Ava Hoffschneider, and Ryan Hoffschneider.

The Pearl Harbor Remembrance Award was created by Colonel Barney Oldfield and his wife Vada to honor the 22 Nebraskans killed during the attack on Pearl Harbor who remain entombed in the U.S.S. Arizona to this day. This fund provides awards to Nebraska high school seniors who applied for but did not receive the Nebraskans of World War II Scholarship. Those receiving the Pearl Harbor Remembrance Awards are **Molly Burke, Katelyn Hetz, Christina Kleinsmith, and Joe Kouba.**


