- Cover letter (2-page maximum) telling the committee each of the following:
 - About yourself, your goals, and your plans to further your education.
 - Any family members who served in WWII or the United States Military (if applicable).
 - Because you attend school in one of the home districts of the sailors entombed in the USS Arizona, which makes you eligible for this scholarship, share your thoughts on what that means to you.
- Original essay should not exceed two pages, and should be based on your interview with a military veteran regarding his/her active service.
- Describe how that encounter influenced and/or affected you.

Please use Times New Roman 12 pt and line spacing of 1.5 for cover letter and essau.

- Current grade transcript
- Current resume that details your community and school activities, honors and awards
- Reference letter from one of your teachers <u>and</u> a second letter from someone other than a relative
- Jpeg head and shoulders photo of yourself
