Reminder - SGP Application Deadline

The application process for the 2025 Spring Statewide Grants Program (SGP) is now open. The **fillable application** may be found <u>here</u> and must be received by **March 31**, **2025**. Any Nebraska local historically focused organization may apply to support efforts such as developing school curriculum, preparing exhibits, processing and preserving artifacts, and undertaking activities such as lectures and museum festivals. Organizations must be recognized 501(c)(3) or part of a local government entity such as a library.


