

Sanborn Map Access

Sanborn maps can provide a wonderful learning opportunity for students. Typically, a person must apply in person for an out-of-county library card with Lincoln City Libraries. However, we have arranged for teachers participating in this program to apply remotely. In addition, you may submit your receipt to NSHSF for reimbursement of the \$15.00 fee. Before applying for a Lincoln Public Library card, please review the following guidelines:

1. Please review the list of communities available below.
2. Be aware that map coverage varies by year and location, and maps may not be applicable to your geographic circumstances. Sanborn maps may or may not cover an entire community.
3. Participating teachers (and schools) must be in the state of Nebraska, but outside of Lancaster county.
